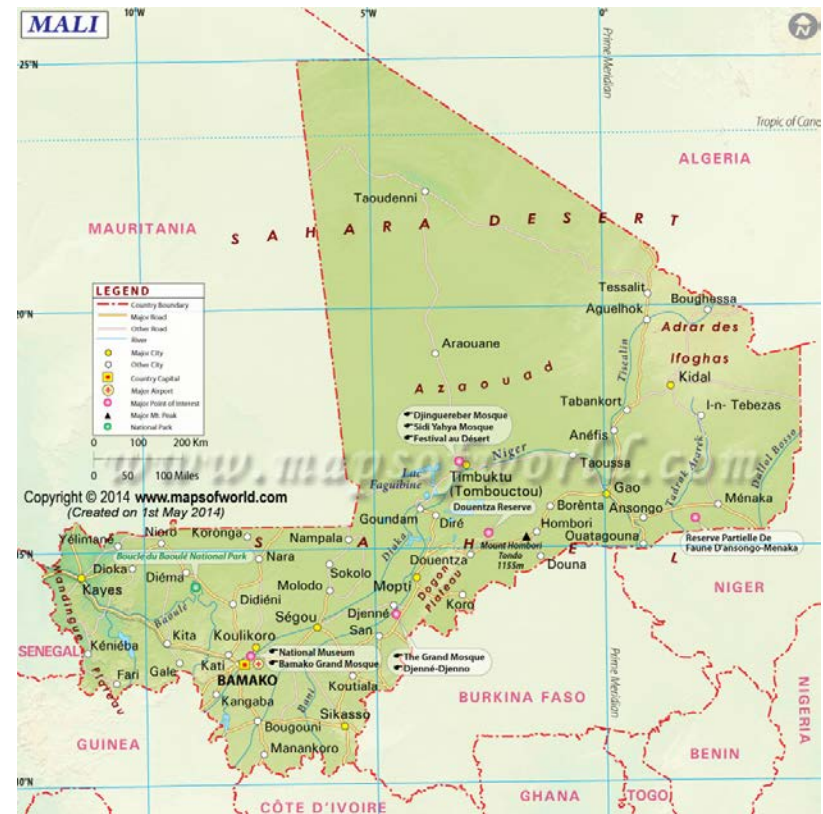


Maps (then)

> *Production de l'espace*

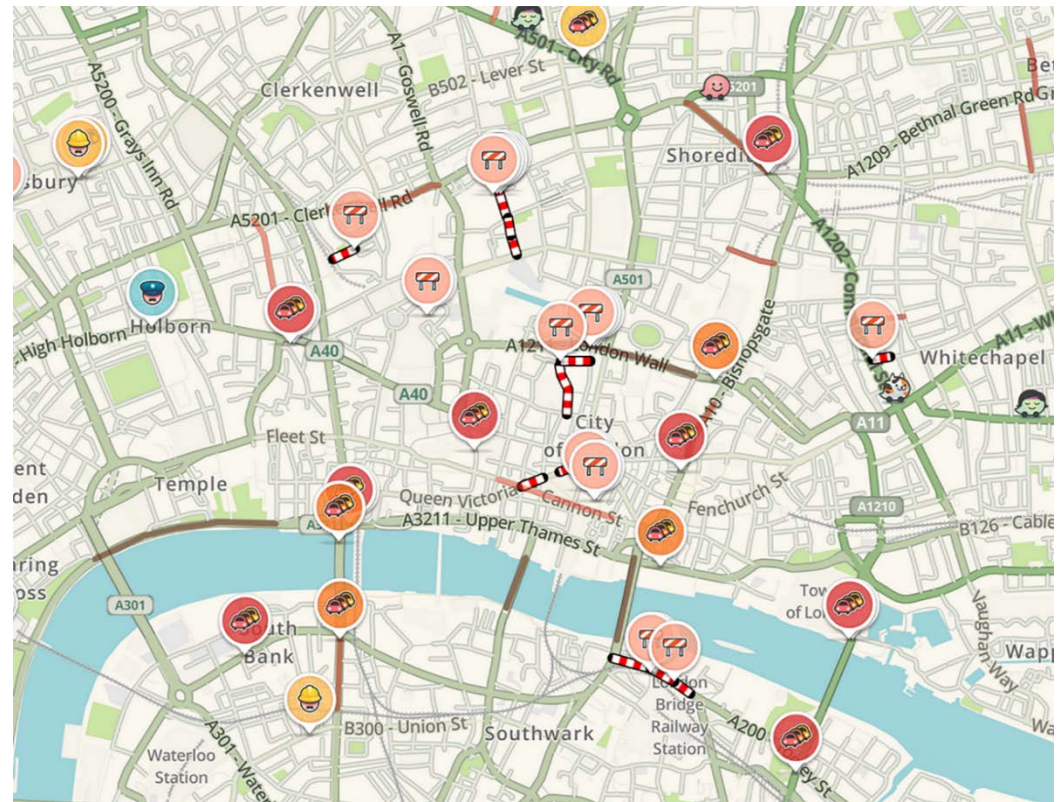
- Behaviour
